You'll need a minimum investment of as little as \$3,000 to as much as \$10,000, which depends on the particular property you want to invest in. You'll invest in shares of each property, with each share representing one acre of farmland. It's also a long-term investment, with an expected payout of between five years and 20 years.

19/8/2013 · The RICS survey identified a national average land value of £6,783 per acre, which is a record

high reflecting the lack of supply in a high demand investment sector. Regionally the most expensive agricultural land is located in the West Midlands at £7,625 per acre with the least expensive being located in Scotland at £3,750 per acre, mainly reflecting the low price of pasture land.

If you have a sufficiently long-term perspective (i.e. at least 25 years), high quality farmland is an exceptionally solid way to maintain and build wealth; high quality farmland is a better long-term investment than gold because it retains its value AND it generates an income rather than requiring the expense of secure storage.

Bottom Line On Land Rental Investments. Buying land to rent out can be a good investment. It depends on a variety of factors, of which not all will get discussed here. But what makes land investing challenging is that a large proportion of the return can come in the form of land appreciation rather than cash flow.

Figure 3 presents the results of a \$1,000 investment had it been made in 1980, near the previous peak in Iowa land values. In 1980, the \$1,000 investment in land would have purchased only .48 acres of land or 7.49 shares of the S&P.

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
