Roosevelt specifically applied the Square Deal to African American citizens, as he did in a

letter in June 1903 to journalist Rollo Ogden: “
[A]ll I wanted was a square deal for the negro.
If he is fit to vote by the test we apply to a

white man, let him vote. If he is unfit, don't.

The Square Deal: Despite his caution,

Roosevelt managed to do enough in his first three years in office to build a platform for election in his own right. In 1902 he resurrected the nearly defunct Sherman

Antitrust Act by bringing a lawsuit that led to the breakup of a huge railroad conglomerate, the Northern Securities Company.
