How to Write a Response Paper - A Step-by-Step Guide. In most cases, your university teacher asks to write an essay on an article/book you have read. You are expected to choose an impersonal, professional voice, which suits the response paper format best. In such essays, rules change slightly.

The introduction to your response paper should include: The title and author of the article you’re responding

to. A one- or two-sentence summary of the article you're writing about.

How to Write a Response Paper. Students who are assigned to complete response papers may use several schemes in organizing and structuring their academic paper. There are several ways how to write a response paper. For instance, you may start your paper with a short summary and then add your response in a block.

How to Write a Response Paper: Useful Tips to Remember. Use short phrases and words as evidence, not sentences or slabs of text (unless it is totally necessary). Read the assignment sheet carefully; do it twice, pen in hand; take some notes. Do not include examples from outside or ideas of others. Tell the story from your personal experience.
