Doing the math: If 1 Gram = 1000 mg (milligrams), by moving the decimal 3 places to the right, then all we have to do to do it backwards is to move the decimal 3 places to the left! Example: $1000\text{mg} = 1\text{g}$. So, how many grams in 2000mg? 2, right? Easy! We're just moving the decimal point 3 places to the left. $1000\text{mg} = 1\text{g}$ $1500\text{mg} = 1.5\text{g}$ $3250\text{mg} = 3.25\text{g}$
